Let's show you the Wesleyan Way!

We've compiled a checklist of dates, links and information that will help you move forward with the enrollment process. Keep this book to ensure you are ready for day one at Wesleyan!

Deposit

Placing your enrollment deposit (\$100 for commuters; \$200 for residential; \$600 for international students) allows us to move forward in helping make all the arrangements for you to be successful at Wesleyan! For commuters and residential students, \$100 is applied to your first semester tuition. For international students, \$500 is applied to your first semester tuition. For residential and international students, \$100 of your deposit is for housing – which will be returned once you move off campus. Deposits are non-refundable after May 1. You can submit your deposit from home at kwc.edu/deposit, by calling us at **270-852-3120** or by visiting us in the Admissions Office.

By depositing early, you receive priority housing options, as assignments are determined on a first-come, first-served basis! You are also able to choose your course schedule early, in addition to the opportunity to familiarize yourself with the Wesleyan community as you meet staff, faculty and future classmates during our first registration events. Most importantly, your enrollment deposit secures your spot on campus this fall so you can enjoy the rest of your summer confident in where life will take you next – Kentucky Wesleyan College. Financial Planning

FAFSA

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (fafsa.ed.gov) is crucial to many students ability to afford a college education. File as soon as you can to ensure maximum aid eligibility. Grants, aid, loans and other opportunities available from the federal government and state programs based on this submission. All students should file a FAFSA online and include Kentucky Wesleyan College in their submission. You can file your FAFSA beginning Oct. 1

Accepting Financial Aid Awards

Once the Financial Aid office has created a financial aid package for you, you should go online and accept your awards to confirm your package! Visit kwc.edu/financial-aid and click on the link in the right-hand column that says "Accept Awards."

Reporting Other Financial Aid

We encourage all students to apply for outside aid to help with college-related costs. All outside aid is required to be reported to the Financial Aid Office. Please use our online form to report all outside scholarships, VA benefits, vocational rehab, tuition remission and other aid at www.kwc.edu/report-other-aid.

Statement of Financial Responsibility

The Statement of Financial Responsibility form is simply an acknowledgement that you, as a student, are choosing to enroll at Kentucky Wesleyan College and tuition and fees are your responsibility. All students are required to complete this form online. It is available at kwc.edu/admitted-students.

Scholarships

Kentucky Wesleyan College does not require a separate application for most scholarships. For academic merit aid, this process begins with official ACT/SAT scores and GPA information submitted as part of your admission credentials. Athletic, talent and other scholarships are available through the appropriate coach, professor or the Financial Aid office. More information is online at kwc.edu/scholarships.

Verification

Each year, roughly 50% of students are selected for verification of FAFSA information as a spot check to ensure efficient and effective use of student aid programs. Kentucky Wesleyan partners with the Kentucky Higher Education Assistance Authority to guide you through verification. AP/IB Scores

At Wesleyan, many of our students have successfully completed Advanced Placement/International Baccalaureate courses. Please have those scores sent to the attention of the Registrar's Office so they can be evaluated and have appropriate coursework credit noted in your academic record.

Dining on Campus

Our students love our campus dining options – Jazzman's Café, SubConnection and the Hocker Family Dining Center. Why? Not only is the food great, but the people get to know what you prefer! Email and Student Portal Access

Once you've submitted your enrollment deposit, our IT staff will send your login credentials to the email address we have on file in the Admissions office. Your login credentials will allow you to access your @kwc.edu email address and student portal. Have questions? Reach out to IT directly at intranet.kwc.edu/help-desk.

FERPA

The Family Education Rights and Privacy Act is a law that assigns parents certain rights with respect to their children's education records. These rights transfer to the student when you reach the age of 18 or arrive at Kentucky Wesleyan College in the fall. To know your rights under FERPA and identify who, if anyone, Wesleyan is authorized to share your educational information (grades, schedule, etc.), an online form must be completed. First Year Experience

The First-Year Experience is planned just for you as you join the Kentucky Wesleyan family. Our program is designed to challenge and support you across the first year and to connect you to outstanding social and learning opportunities that will help you to achieve your academic goals. Specific information will be provided prior to your arrival to campus.

Health Form

All students are required to complete a health history form, so we are able to provide care and support for you as a student at Wesleyan. Your health information is private, so you must print the form provided online and mail the form or deliver it to campus. The form is available online at **kwc.edu/admitted-students**.

Housing


All students must complete the Housing/Commuter form online. Living on campus is one of the experiences Wesleyan students enjoy the most. Our five residence halls and close proximity to our 200+ student events and activities each year add to the student experience. Immunization Record

As part of your complete health profile in Student Health Services, we need a copy of your immunizations records. They can be included with the Health Form by mail or delivered to campus when you arrive.

Meningitis Information Form

Kentucky law requires students be informed of Meningitis, a rare disease of which college students are at a slightly increased risk than the general population. The form is online and must be completed by all students. The form is available online at **kwc.edu/admitted-students**.



Official, Final Transcripts

All admissions decisions are considered provisional until the receipt of an official, final transcript from your high school. This transcript must include your graduation date. Financial Aid eligibility is dependent on receipt of this final transcript.

One Call Now

Kentucky Wesleyan College uses One Call Now as a mass communication system for community-wide announcements, for snow schedule notifications or for emergency situations. It is highly recommended that all students sign up. The online form is available at kwc.edu/admitted-students.

Parking on Campus

Parking at Wesleyan is a cinch! You'll have the opportunity to park near all your classroom buildings and residence halls year round. No shuttle service required! Parking is included in tuition and fees. All cars on campus must be registered through the Student Services office. Register online at kwc.thepermitstore.com.

Student ID

All students are issued an official Kentucky Wesleyan College ID. This card gives you rights to access campus facilities, events and resources. Wesleyan students must have their Student ID in their possession at all times. Student IDs will be issued during Future Panther Day sessions.

Student Insurance

All full-time students should have health insurance. As part of your health profile, students should submit a photo or scanned copy of the front and back of your health insurance card and submit it online to our Student Health Services. The online form is available at kwc.edu/admitted-students.

Textbooks

For your convenience, Kentucky Wesleyan College has a completely online bookstore. This allows you to order your books from home and pick them up from the campus post office when you arrive!

Updated ACT/SAT Scores

Have you retaken the ACT/SAT since you received your admission decision to Kentucky Wesleyan College? If so, make sure you request those scores be sent to Wesleyan as they can improve your financial aid package!


