We've compiled a checklist of dates, links and information that will help you move forward with the enrollment process. Keep this book to ensure you are ready for day one at Wesleyan!

To Do Immediately

☐ Deposit

Our enrollment deposit is \$100 for commuters; \$200 for residential; \$600 for international students. For commuters and residential students, \$100 is applied to your first semester tuition and fees. For international students, \$500 is applied to your first semester tuition and fees. Enrollment deposits are non-refundable after May 1. You can submit your deposit from home at kwc.edu/deposit, or by calling us at **270-852-3120**.

☐ Advising and Registration

Students should plan to attend Wesleyan Way Day on one of the following dates: **April 27, June 14, July 19**

☐ Residency Information

All students must submit the Residency Form whether living at home or on campus. The form is online at kwc.edu/admitted and will be submitted directly to Student Services.

Additional information you need to enroll

After January

☐ Submit Required Forms

All students must submit the required forms found on kwc.edu/admitted. These include:

- FERPA Release Form
- Mailbox Key Deposit
- Student Advising Survey
- Student Health Form
- Statement of Financial Responsibility
- Student ID Photo Submission

☐ Email and Student Portal Access

Beginning in January and continuing until August, IT staff will send deposited students log-in information. With this, you will be able to check your email, the status of forms, financial aid, and review your class schedule. Email and the student portal are online at kwc.edu/current-students.

At the end of Spring Semester

☐ Final High School Transcript

Federal financial aid requires the receipt of a final high school transcript that shows the day your diploma was awarded. Before graduation, make sure to request that your high school send us a final transcript!

☐ Register your vehicle

If you are bringing a car to campus, make sure to register for your parking pass. There is no fee, but you must have a parking pass to park on campus. You can complete it online after June 1 at kwc.thepermitstore.com.

☐ Latest ACT, SAT, AP, IB, or Dual Credit Information

Did you take the ACT or SAT in the spring after you were admitted to Wesleyan? Make sure we have all of your scores! Additionally, if you completed Advanced Placement exams, International Baccalaureate, or Dual Credit courses, make sure you request scores/transcripts from the appropriate provider so we can update your registration record.

To Do Immediately

☐ Submit Your FAFSA

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) can be filed beginning **October 1st**. Don't wait - filing early helps maximize federal and state aid eligibility! File online at studentaid.gov and add Kentucky Wesleyan College with our school code **001969**.

☐ Review Financial Aid Offer

After you are admitted and we receive your completed FAFSA, you will receive a financial aid offer. Be looking for a call from your admissions counselor to review it and discuss strategies to make Wesleyan affordable for your family.

Before Arriving to Campus

☐ Accepting Your Awards

After you have submitted your deposit, you will need to accept your official financial aid award through your Financial Aid portal. You will receive instructions on how to access this portal and accept your aid after we receive your deposit.

☐ Complete All Financial Aid Steps

If possible, plan a trip to campus to meet with our financial aid team in the summer to review all necessary steps and information to finalize scholarships, verification, grants, aid and loan steps to ease your arrival to campus in the fall.
