Kentucky Wesleyan College offers pre-professional preparation for students who plan to pursue engineering. After completing approximately three years at Wesleyan, you will be prepared to apply to an accredited engineering school. After completing two years in the engineering program of your choice, you will gain a bachelor's degree from Kentucky Wesleyan and a bachelor of science in engineering from your chosen engineering school.

When you complete the engineering school curriculum, you will then receive an undergraduate B.S. degree from Kentucky Wesleyan (typically in physics, chemistry or applied mathematics) and a second B.S. degree from the engineering school.

EXCEPTIONAL PREPARATION

Obtaining a degree in engineering from Wesleyan allows you to complete many of your general education courses in a small class setting. It also shows future employers that you have the ability to learn from multiple sources. If you choose to double major or minor, you will prove your versatility in a competitive market. Personalized guidance from faculty advisors ensures that your skills align with your goals and entrance requirements.

Kentucky Wesleyan Pre-Engineering students have been accepted into engineering programs at the University of Kentucky, Vanderbilt University, Auburn University, Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology, the University of North Carolina, the University of the Pacific, Western Kentucky University, the University of Illinois-Champaign-Urbana and the University of Evansville.
