What is The Wesleyan Edge?

The Wesleyan Edge is a four-year program to prepare our students for success beyond their graduation from Kentucky Wesleyan. From day one at Kentucky Wesleyan, The Wesleyan Edge helps you to “advance your future.” This program provides a step-by-step guide to assessing skills and gaining relevant experiences, utilizing the support of all areas of the College. The program begins the moment a student commits to Kentucky Wesleyan and continues beyond graduation as students transition into alumni.

What are the benefits and requirements of participating in The Wesleyan Edge?

Students are provided with steps each year to prepare them for life after graduation. Each year, there are incentives for completing those steps.

First-Year Students

- Complete the required Freshman Seminar (KW101), complete a Personal Development plan with their advisor, plus engage in other College-sponsored activities.
- Upon completion of the first year of the program, students earn a \$500 credit on their tuition for sophomore year.

Sophomore Students

- Complete the Sophomore Experience Program, begin preparing for a career, and continue to engage with the campus.
- Upon completion of the sophomore year, students earn as much as a \$1,000 grant toward tuition in their junior year.

Junior Year

- Juniors continue their career preparation and campus engagement plus they attend the Wesleyan into the World program in January.
- Students who successfully complete The Wesleyan Edge in junior year will have their graduation fee waived and will be able to attend the Business Etiquette Dinner free of charge.

Senior Year

- By senior year, students are ready to take steps toward life after Kentucky Wesleyan and will apply for jobs and/or graduate school. Resources are provided to help with this process.
- Students who have completed all four years of The Wesleyan Edge will be awarded a certificate of completion at the Honors Convocation, a cord for commencement and will have earned the right to include The Wesleyan Edge on their resume.
