Our Housing Facilities

We have 5 housing options here at KWC!

Deacon is a mixed-gendered building, with floors being separated down the middle into male and female.

Peeples Hall is a mixed-gendered building, with each floor holding a specific gender.

Kendall Hall holds a kitchen and is also a mixed-gendered hall by floor.

Massie is suite style living by gender. Stadium is apartment style living and is traditionally for upperclassman students.

Housing Accommodations

If you believe that you qualify for any type of housing accommodation, then you need to contact Lori Thurman at your earliest convenience. We will do our best to meet housing accommodations, but we do have limited single rooms on campus. As Miss Thurman is able to process housing accommodations, she will update the Office of Residence Life, and students with accommodations will be placed in available spaces that meet their accommodation. We will do our best to place students in spaces that meet their accommodations as well as in buildings they prefer, however, students should note that if they opt into a more expensive residence hall, they will pay an increased rate for their accommodation.

Director of Residence Life Hannah Vanderpohl will be in contact with all students who receive an accommodation to understand their preferences and to make a placement. If a student receives an accommodation and there are no more singles available, they will be added to the top of the singles waitlist.

Residency Information Form

In your student portal, after submitting your deposit, you will have access to the Residency Information Form. This form must be completed at your earliest convenience. This form will let the Residence Life Office at KWC know if you intend to live on campus or off-campus, your roommate preferences, and your housing preferences. Students new to housing at KWC are placed by hand by the Director of Residence Life, utilizing preferences expressed in the Residency Information Form. Placements begin in April and roll until July 1.

We strive to meet housing preferences, but due to occupancy constraints, we cannot guarantee that students will be placed in their top preference for housing. Roommate preferences will be honored as long as both students request one another.

Must Haves

FAQs

Here are some frequently asked questions:

- What do meal plans look like?
 - Meal Plans come in 3 options
 - Option 1 is 12 meals weekly and 350 flex dollars a semester
 - Option 2 is 16 meals weekly and 100 flex dollars a semester
 - Option 3 is 19 meals weekly and 50 flex dollars a semester
 - All plans cost the same, but we recommend that your student pick the plan that is best for them. The default plan is for 12 meals weekly. Meal plans can be changed in student life during the first week of school!
- What items are prohibited in the residence halls?
 - A comprehensive list can be found in the student handbook, but here are some of the more common items we do not allow
 - Hot Plates, Air Fryers, Candles, Toasters, Space Heaters, Incense, Weapons, and Hoverboards
 - We require microwaves to have no more than 700 watts, and refrigerators should require 2 amps or less.
